Personal Property Policies

Revised January 2024

Campers:

- Possession of Alcohol and Illegal Drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- Possession of weapons at camp is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- Campers are not allowed to bring pets
- Campers can bring electronics, but all screens will be taken and stored in the office at the start of camp, to be given back to the camper at the end of camp (and phones will be given back during call-home days only).
- Campers should know any electronics plugged into outlets during a storm have a risk of being damaged.
- Campers are not allowed to have personal cars at camp.
- Campers should be mindful of their personal instruments, keeping them safe, not leaving them unattended or outside, and properly cleaning and storing them after each use. We have instrument repair shops nearby, but these repairs are done at the cost of the camper's family.

Staff:

- Possession of Alcohol and Illegal Drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- Possession of weapons at camp is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- Pets are only allowed for staff who do not live with the campers in cabins, and pets are only allowed at the discretion of the directors.
- Staff are welcome to bring any electronics to camp, but are warned not to keep them plugged in during thunderstorms for risk of being fried.
- Staff should know all music supplies and instruments are the responsibility of the staff member. All practice studios remain open and unlocked throughout the summer, so leaving materials in your studio is at your own risk.
- Staff are encouraged to bring their cars to camp. Any staff member that does not have their own vehicle may take a driving test and sign out a camp vehicle if one is free when needing to leave for time off or an errand.
- Junior counselors may have a car at camp, but are not allowed to drive anyone except themselves.
- We have instrument repair shops nearby, but these repairs are done at the cost of the staff member.
